
HELP FILE 1- Access the Analytical Module

Indico.UN users shall be granted a *reporter* role to access the Analytical Module. Reporters may view data reports on a category, subcategory, or event depending on the level of permission granted.

A reporter may access the Analytical Module through the Analytical module link available on the Indico.UN interface or in other ways described below.

Access via Indico.UN

On your category/subcategory page or an event page, you will see the Analytical Module link on the right side of the screen.



Click on the link to be redirected to the Analytical Module reports

Save the link to your Favorites to access the reports directly on your next visit.


The system may ask for your United Identity credentials when you next access the Module. Please enter them as required.

Access via Power BI

Only Indico.UN users who are granted a *reporter* role and <u>with a UN domain account</u> may access the Analytical Module via the PBI workspace.


The Indico.UN team has provided you access to the Power BI content of the Analytical Module reports: *Indico.UN AM*.

If client specific reports have been created for your organization, you may have a different view.


Still more ways to open a report
